## GARDEN ETIQUETTE

Thank you for visiting Alta Vista Gardens today. The Garden is a living museum open to the public and will feature one of the most diverse plant and art collections in the United States. We are excited to provide an educational experience for you and your group.

### All visitors are required to observe the following Garden guidelines:

- Please respect the Botanic Garden; treat it as you would treat your own home.
- Trash containers are located throughout the Garden for your convenience. Please place all litter in the bins provided.
- Pets are welcome, but must be under tight control. Dogs must be leashed. Clean up after your dog, as per City of Vista ordinance. Dogs are not allowed in the ponds.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult chaperone at all times.
- Stay on the paths.
- Skating, skateboarding and rollerblading are not permitted.
- No climbing on trees or structures.
- Picnic only at tables, benches and lawn areas.
- No smoking, no fires.
- It is strictly forbidden to remove plants or parts of plants from the Garden. Refrain from picking flowers, fruits, nuts and seeds, so that all can enjoy.
- Please do not disturb the wildlife.
- Ponds are delicate ecosystems. Do not place any food, sticks or other foreign objects in ponds. Dogs are not allowed in ponds.
- Cars are allowed only in designated areas.
